March 7, 1957 - March 8, 2024

Royce Allan Brown, of Moore, OK, went to his heavenly home on March 8, 2024. He was 67 years old.

Royce was born on March 7, 1957, to Logan W. & Virginia (Matthews) Brown and grew up in rural Miami, OK.

He graduated from Miami High School in 1975 and moved to Wyoming to work on the oil pipelines for a few years. He then moved back to Miami and drove trucks for various local companies for several years.

In 1988 he moved to Iowa and began driving trucks for Wal-Mart, and eventually transferred to Loveland, Colorado to drive for them regionally.

In 1999 he returned to Oklahoma and started college at OU to earn his degree in electrical engineering. After graduating from OU, he worked as an electrical engineer at Tinker Air Force Base and retired in 2020.

Royce loved working on model railroad projects and was a member of the Oklahoma Model Railroad Association and Museum. He was also an avid amateur radio operator.

Royce was preceded in death by his mother Virginia Brown, and his younger

sister Lea Ann Baker. He is survived by his father, Logan W. Brown of Miami, OK; sister Sandy Goettel and husband Don of Miami, OK; brother Mike Brown and wife Becky of Broken Arrow, OK; brother-in-law John Baker of Edmond, OK as well as several nieces, nephews, cousins.

Graveside services will be 1:00 PM, Tuesday, March 12, 2024, at the Fairland Cemetery. Services have been placed in the care of Brown-Winters Funeral Home and Cremation Service in Miami.
