Russell Arnold was born on August 3, 1923 to Dan and Della Arnold in Overbrook, Kansas.

He was United in marriage to Sylvia Maxine Arnold on November 7, 1944. Of this marriage one child was born.

Russell served in the United States Army as military police in World War II, 1941-1945. He was honorably discharged in January 1946.

In 1951 Russell became a chef at the ammunition plant in Parsons, Kansas where he had a good friend "Leo" teaching him how to cut meat. Russell was a meat cutter for the remainder of his adult work life.

In 1954 he became a Christian and member of Connor Ave. Baptist Church in Joplin, Missouri.

Russell was ordained as a deacon at the Calvary Baptist Church in Columbus, Kansas, September 22, 1963.
