



## Sam Moseley

June 19, 1941 - August 20, 2020

Sam Moseley, 79, a longtime Miami resident passed away at his home on Thursday Morning, August 20, 2020. He was born June 19, 1941 to B.C. and Frances (Robbins) Moseley in Ketchum, Oklahoma. Sam graduated with the Class of 1959 from Vinita High School before going on to NEO A&M College. He worked at BF Goodrich and then at Miami Tire for his brother Pete. 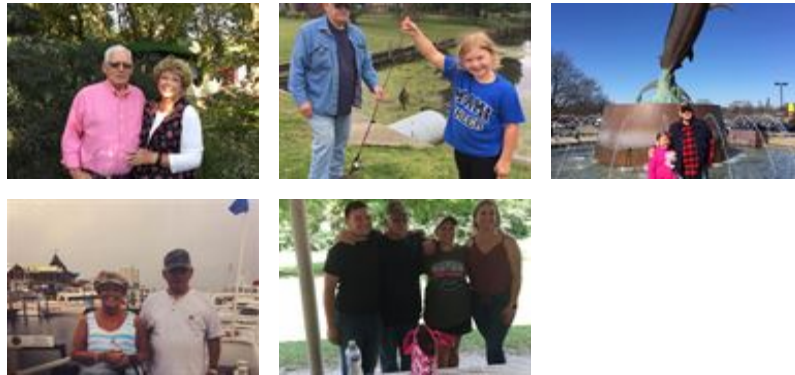
