Tanner Keagan Gene Hodges, 23, a United States Army Combat Engineer, passed away on Friday, February 27, 2026. Tanner was born on February 5, 2003, in Fort Riley, Kansas, to Jeremy G. and Angela M. (Oldt) Hodges. Tanner graduated with the class of 2021 from Columbus High School in Columbus, Kansas. In High school, Tanner loved sports and anything outdoors. He wrestled and played football, enjoyed being outside, hunted deer, and loved going fishing with his grandpa. One of the things Tanner also enjoyed was singing Karaoke when he had an opportunity. He later joined the United States Army, where he worked as a Combat Engineer. He was currently stationed in Fort Carson, Colorado. Mr. Hodges was preceded in passing by his maternal grandmother, Lynda Oldt, and paternal grandfather, Roy Gene Hodges.

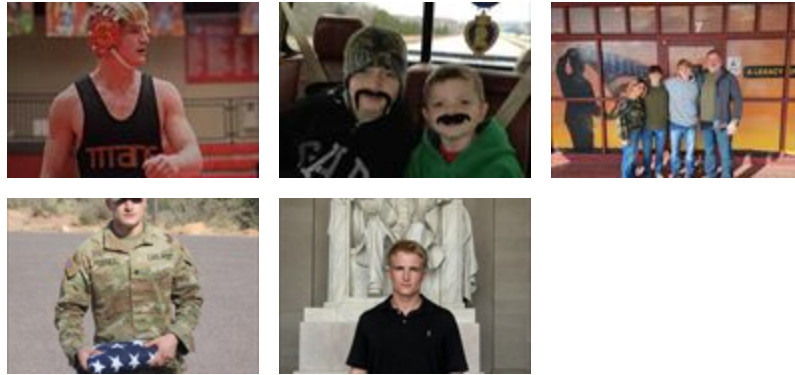

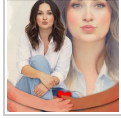
