Terry Chase, 74, of Fairland, Oklahoma passed away at Freeman Health System in Joplin Sunday, January 5, 2014 from complications following heart surgery. Terry was born on October 25, 1939 in Seminole, Oklahoma to Herb and Jeanette (Couk) Chase. He was an entrepreneur and business man, owning furniture stores in various cities in Oklahoma and Arkansas.
