Tommy Wayne Malcolm, 83, a longtime Miami resident passed away Sunday, September 15, 2013 at Freeman Health System in Joplin. He was born in Miami on March 26, 1930 to Thomas William and Myrtle Standiffer Malcolm. Mr. Malcolm married his wife of sixty-one years Bette Blevins in Huntsville, Arkansas on September 29, 1952. He was a member of the United States Army where he retired after twenty-two years. Tommy worked in communications while he served in the Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam and Germany.
