Tyler Joe Vincent, 30, a longtime Fairland Resident passed away on Saturday, June 29, 2019 in Fairland. Tyler was born on February 28, 1989 in Miami to Terry J. and Kelly Ann Vincent. He graduated from Fairland High School with the Class of 2008. He completed his education at Northeast Vo-Tech Center in Afton where he studied Welding. One week after graduation he started his dream of becoming a welder working on the road for the past 11 years as a pipeline welder. He was a member of the 798 Pipeliner's Union out of Tulsa, Oklahoma. Tyler was an avid hunter and fisherman. Tyler enjoyed being Uncle Ty Ty, and loved to spend time with his nieces and nephews when he was home for visits. He was a good cook and enjoyed collecting and trading guns. He above all was a loyal, trustworthy friend.

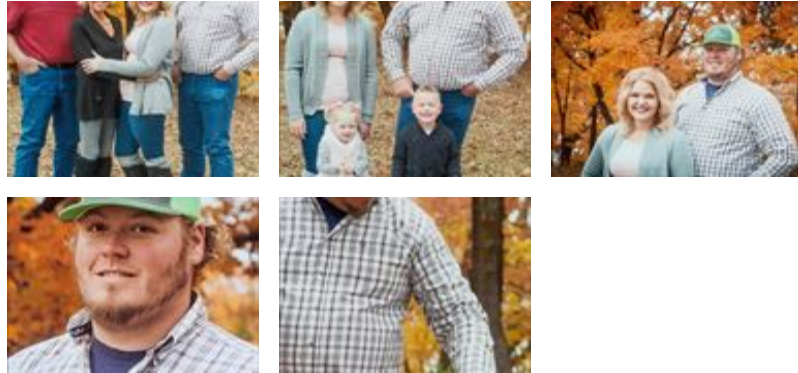

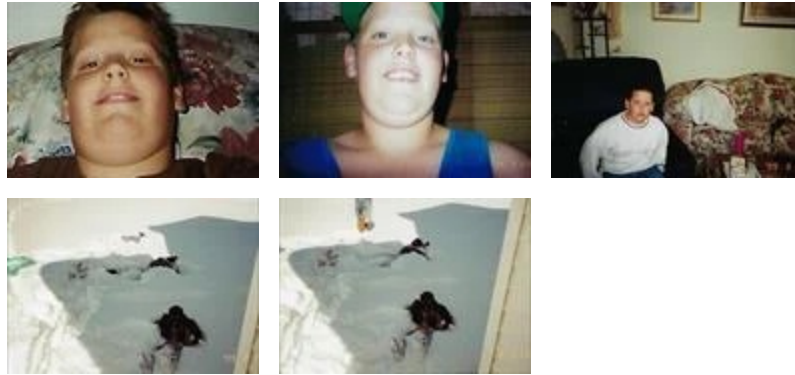

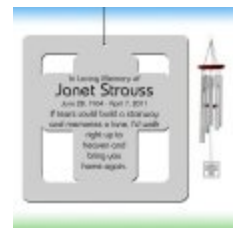
