William M. Miller, 90, of Fairland passed away at the Family Care Center in Fairland on Wednesday, May 4. He was born in western Kansas on September 18, 1925 and had lived in Fairland since 1995. He is survived by his wife, Madaleen, his two sisters, Pat Howard and Eleanor Miller, his brother Robert, and his four children: Kendall, Alison, Ellen and Brian, and their families, which includes 13 grandchildren and 8 greatgrandchildren, plus two foster children from Pakistan, Sahib Zahda and Saeed Miller and their families.

He also possessed a profound sense of humor that endeared him to all, and made him the favorite uncle to a host of nieces and nephews and all the members of the Montgomery/Williston/Miller clan that has lived in the four-state area for generations.
