August 12, 1917 - December 28, 2013

Wilma Ellen Daniels a 96 year old Grove resident went home to be with her Lord, Saturday December 28, 2013 at Grand Lake Villa. Wilma or to her grandchildren "Grandma D" was born on August 12, 1917 in Pulaski, Pennsylvania to Mont and Mary (Powell) Clark. She graduated from the West Middlesex High School in 1936.
